require trial.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defense attorneys shall meet with the prosecutors at

least four (4) weeks prior to the criminal trial effective January 1, 2022 but the Court encourages

this process to start immediately. The Court is aware that the dockets cannot be printed in advance

as the service information will not be updated, therefore all counsel will be required to review the

dockets on the Court's calendar found on the clerk of Court site - criminal division and adequately

prepare and meet with their clients. Failure to comply shall result in a Rule to Show Cause before

this Court.
